Eagle Lake Sports Association Small Ball Rules and Guidelines

Field Layout:

- 1. Bases will be 50 feet apart.
- 2. The pitcher's mound will be 35 feet from the back of the Home Plate

General:

- 1. This is an instructional League only. Runs and outs will not be kept, and we encourage the parents not to keep track either.
- 2. Small Ball teams will be limited to no more than 8 players per team; also, Small Ball players are not eligible for All-Stars.
- 3. We will follow the 3F's of baseball:
 - a. Have Fun
 - b. Make Friends
 - c. Learn Fundamentals
- 4. All Games will be a minimum of 20 minutes and have a drop-dead time of 45 minutes.
- 5. All Players must be in uniform, which consist of the following
 - a. Jersey
 - b. Pants (THIS ITEM IS NOT PROVIDED BY ELSA)
 - c. Team Cap
- 6. Players WILL NOT be allowed to wear jewelry of any kind. Medical alert items are not considered Jewelry.
- 7. All Base-Runners, Batters, and On-Deck Batters must wear a helmet at all times.
- 8. Since outs will not count in ELSA Small Ball, teams will switch from Offense to Defense after the last batter on the Offensive team has had a chance to bat the ball into play.

Batting:

- 1. Before the Ball can be put into play, the Plate Coach must call out "Play Ball" in order to make sure all fielders are paying attention.
- 2. Batters will be allowed to swing at the ball until the ball is hit into fair territory (at least 10 feet from the plate)
- 3. "Bunting" will not be permitted.
- 4. Bat Throwing will not be tolerated. Coaches are expected to teach players how to properly put the bat down after the ball is put into play.

- 5. Batters and/or Base-Runners will be allowed only one base every time the ball is put into play.
- 6. Stealing or leading off will not be permitted.
- 7. Plate Coach must call out "last Batter" when the last batter approaches the plate.
- 8. Teams must use Approved bats by Cal Ripken/Babe Ruth
 - ** NO BIG BARREL BATS ALLOWED **

Fielding:

- 1. Time will be called when the ball has been fielded and thrown to any base with the intent of making a play.
- 2. Teams on Defense "MUST" field all players every inning (unless player is injured or sick)
- 3. The positions to be fielded by the Defense are the listed below:
 - a. The 3 bases
 - b. Pitcher
 - c. Shortstop
 - d. Up to 3 rovers
 - e. Due to Safety Precautions, the Catcher position will not be fielded
- 4. We ask that a different 1B, P, and 3B be used each inning of a game to encourage development and enjoyment for more possible players.
